NOTICE FOR WALK IN INTERVIEW

A **walk in interview** will be held in the Department of **Community Medicine**, Agartala Government Medical College on **25th August, 2015** for recruiting the following manpower for "Establishment of Model Rural Health Research Units (MRHRUs) in the State of Tripura" under the scheme of Development of Infrastructure for promotion of Health Research.

The type of recruitment will be purely **temporary** basis, as shown bellow.

1. Name of the post: **Scientist D (Medical): 1 posts (Unreserved)**

• **Essential qualifications:**

Post graduate degree (MD/MS) with five year R&D/teaching experience or Postgraduate diploma in medical subjects with six years R&D/teaching experience from recognized university

Or

MBBS degree recognized by MCI or equivalent degree from recognized University with 8 years R&D/Teaching experience in medical subjects after MBBS Degree. Preferences will be given to candidates having experience in Public Health/Medicine.

• **Desirable qualifications:**

- (i) Additional Post doctoral research/teaching experience in medical subjects in recognized institute(s)
- (ii) Knowledge of Computer Applications or Business Intelligence tools /Data Management

Age Limit: Not exceeding 45 years. Relax-able for SC/ST/OBC candidates in accordance with the Govt, of India rules. A retired physically fit person up to the age of 65 years having the essential qualifications may also be considered at the discretion of the committee.

Salary: Rs. 60,000/- per month (fixed)

2. **Technical Assistant (Statistician): 1 posts (Unreserved)**

• **Essential qualifications:**

Three years Graduate Degree in Mathematics/Statistics from a recognized University with 5 years experience

Or

Three years Graduate Degree in Mathematics/Statistics from a recognized University with diploma in the relevant subjects and 3 years experience in a Govt, recognized Institute/Organizations

• **Desirable qualifications:**

(i) Master's Degree in Statistics and knowledge of statistics related computer and other advanced computer software applicable to Health Research.

(ii) Knowledge of Computer Applications

Age limit: Not exceeding 35 years. Relax-able for SC/ST/OBC candidates in accordance with the Govt, of India rules

Salary: Rs 31,000/- per month (fixed)

3. Technician C (Laboratory Technician): 1 posts (Unreserved)

• **Essential qualifications:**

10+2 with Science subjects or equivalent from a recognized board with one year Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) or relevant subject from Govt, recognized Organizations/ Institute/ Medical College and One year experience in recognized Institute.

Or

10+2 with Science subject with two years Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) or relevant subject.

• **Desirable qualifications:**

(i) B. Sc. In Medical Laboratory Technology

(ii) Two years experience in Govt, recognized Organizations/ Institute/ Medical College. Age limit: Not exceeding 30 years. Relax-able for SC/ST/OBC candidates in accordance with the Govt, of India rules

Salary: Rs. 21,000/- per month (fixed)
